



MASTERS SCOTCH DOUBLES VEGAS QUALIFIER

*Open to active Birmingham APA Players
with an 8-Ball SL of 6 or higher.*

RULES & DETAILS

- Players must be active during the current session and in good standings in our league. Once qualified, players must remain active throughout the session the national event takes place.
- To participate in this Vegas Qualifier, players must have at least 10 regular **APA** 8-Ball scores within the past 2 years. To play in Vegas, a player must have a total of 20 **APA** 8-Ball and/or 9-Ball scores (can be a combination of both formats) within the past 2 years.
- Total team points must be 12 to 14 points. Match races are as follows:
12 pts - Race to 4 Games / **13 pts** - Race to 5 Games / **14 pts** - Race to 6 Games
- Teams will lag for the initial break and team members must alternate shots throughout the matches including when breaking.
- Only ONE coach (time-out) per team per rack.
- Team members may talk and strategize while opponents are shooting but NO talking, or signaling, your partner while it's your turn at the table.
1st offense = Warning • 2nd = Ball-in-Hand to Opponent • 3rd = Loss of Match & disqualified
- Teams have 5 minutes to get to the assigned table once called before forfeiting your match.
- NO earbuds, headsets, earplugs, etc. may be worn during your matches.
- **Jump Cues** can be used if needed.
- Smoke breaks can only be taken in between match rounds and NOT during your match.
- Any questionable "close hit" shots should be watched by the Tournament Director, or appointed referee. Shots not watched will go to the team shooting.
- "NO SHOW" teams will still owe any unpaid entry fees unless replaced by another team.
- Teams should mark the pocket for the 8-Ball with something personal and not chalk.
- Trophies and total prize money will be based on the number of teams who enter. See the tournament board at each event for breakdown.
- The 1st Place team will choose 1 or 2 other **Birmingham APA** players to make up their 3 to 4 man team to compete in the upcoming APA Masters Championship in August.
- 1st Place prize monies (travel assistance) will be paid out by the end of the month before the APA Masters Championship in Vegas. Players who don't attend MUST pay back any monies received from this tourney.
